

SCOUTS ACT COVID SAFE

Scout Halls & Meeting places – Step 7.1



See Scouts ACT Overview document for broad requirements

Face masks are no longer required for Scouting meetings and events, except where they may include high risk settings, e.g., public transport and hospitals

All attendees to be recorded. Meeting places to have the *Check in CBR* app QR code displayed, for use by those who voluntarily wish to check in using the QR code

Attendance is voluntary, Groups and Units able to determine the form of meeting



Maintain good hygiene and cleaning

- Provide sanitiser at all entrances to the Scout Hall, remind participants to maintain hand hygiene and to practise respiratory hygiene
- Touch surfaces and activity equipment to be regularly sanitised, and minimise sharing of activity equipment



Stay Physically Distant

- Building density restrictions no longer apply
- 1.5 metres physical distancing is recommended, and handshaking not recommended
- Arrange parent drop-off and pick-up outside of Scout Hall



Follow Advice

- Start of meetings briefing ensure current arrangements are understood
- Stay home if unwell, if someone becomes unwell arrange for the person to be returned home
