

SCOUTS ACT – COVID SAFE SCOUTING OVERVIEW

STEP 7.1 – 16 April 2022

Face masks are no longer required for Scouting meetings and events, except where they may include high risk settings, e.g., public transport and hospitals

Density restrictions no longer apply

All attendees to be recorded. Meeting places to have the *Check in CBR* app QR code displayed, for use by those who voluntarily wish to check in using the QR code

What happens

Weekly, outdoor, and overnight activities; Camp Cottermouth open; attendance is voluntary

Activities permitted in the ACT. Activities also permitted outside the ACT, however check for the latest conditions of other jurisdictions when planning, and before commencement of, any such activities

Requirements

Sensible personal protection - 1.5 metres apart recommended, sanitiser freely available, maintain good hygiene

Vehicles may carry passengers from more than one household

GL and/or President ensures premises suitable for use. Hall hirers briefed on operational arrangements

Stay home if unwell, and anyone not well to be excluded and their return to home arranged

Child safe practices maintained
