



# SCOUTS ACT COVID SAFE

## Camp Cottermouth – Scouts ACT – Step 6.3



This document covers Scouting usage of Camp Cottermouth from Friday 12 November 2021, subject to ACT Government Health Directions at that date and into the future. It takes into account the ACT Government Pathway Forward from 12 November as revised on 9 November 2021.

The Camp is available for day usage, camping and cabin usage. Some non-Scouting groups may also be allowed access.

Usage of the camp has the following restrictions, most set by the ACT Government:

- All groups or individuals who wish to visit the camp must make a booking with the Camp Managers, Allison and Dallas Shang, preferably via email at [campcottermouth@scoutsact.com.au](mailto:campcottermouth@scoutsact.com.au).
- All persons aged 16 years and older entering the camp must use the Check In CBR app to register. Check in locations are adjacent to the Shakespeare Centre as that is the best location for mobile phone or WiFi access.
- The leader of each group of visitors must also maintain a register of all persons of any age in the group.
- Facemasks are not required for users of the camp.
- Gatherings at the camp will be limited to no more than 1,000 persons unless special arrangements are made with the camp. No outdoor space density limits apply. All usage of indoor spaces at the camp is limited to one person per 2sqm. Indoor spaces include the stage and the Mall shade shelter if its sides are installed.
- Sleeping accommodation including tents and cabins is limited to 1 person per 2sqm. This means that tents smaller than 4sqm can only sleep 1 person or family.
- All groups and visitors must also abide by current Scouting and ACT Government guidelines in relation to Social Distancing and Hygiene while at Camp Cottermouth. There must be no sharing of plated food or personal utensils.

We look forward to welcoming you to Camp Cottermouth and request you abide by current rules and guidelines to make this a safe and accessible location for all members of Scouting to enjoy.
