

SCOUTS ACT COVID SAFE

Outdoor Activities – Scouts ACT – Step 6.3



All attendees to be recorded

Scouting premises used within the ACT to have the *Check in CBR* app QR code, with the *Check in CBR* app required for use by those 16 years and older who enter the premises

For non Scouting premises comply with QR code check in requirements

Face masks not required for outdoor activities

Attendance is voluntary

Activities permitted within the ACT

From 1 November, activities permitted anywhere in NSW and Victoria, however check for the latest conditions of those jurisdictions before planning and commencing any such activities



Maintain good hygiene and cleaning

- Provide sanitiser at all outdoor activities
- Arrange that touch surfaces and activity equipment be regularly sanitised
- Facilitate maintaining hand hygiene and hand washing regimes
- Remind participants to practise respiratory hygiene



Stay Physically Distant

- Comply with current government group gathering limits. Currently up to 1000 persons permitted for groups undertaking outdoor activities, without density restrictions. Larger groups permitted with additional requirements.
- Maintain recommended government physical distancing requirements, including when on the premises of third party providers, 1.5m where possible
- Accommodation arrangements to satisfy 2 sqm per person. This applies to all types of accommodation including buildings and tents, exceptions being for immediate family members.
- Vehicles may carry passengers from more than one household

- Comply with food handling and catering restrictions, i.e. no buffet style catering
- Where possible, minimise sharing of activity equipment
- No handshaking



Follow Advice

- Stay home when sick
- Exclude yourself and arrange to return home if you become unwell during an activity
- Normal activity approval processes are followed, and record all attendees
- Ensure a pre activity briefing occurs, including information about current restrictions and good practice arrangements
- All adventurous activities are permitted if qualification and approval arrangements are in place, and the Scouting Leader responsible for the technical aspects of the adventurous activity is satisfied to do so. The use of third party providers for adventurous activities is permitted if the provider meets current COVID arrangements, which may vary according to the jurisdiction; and Scouting activity approval arrangements have been satisfied

Note adventurous activities requiring close contact are progressively resuming

- Adventurous Activities will consider any additional activity specific requirements, and detail these in activity planning and risk documentation prepared as part of the activity approval process
- In the event of an emergency standard emergency response procedures apply
