Scout Halls & Meeting places – Step 6.3



All attendees to be recorded

Meeting places to have the *Check in CBR* app QR code, with the *Check in CBR* app required to be used by those 16 years and older who enter the premises

Face masks not required in Scout Halls; though individual Scout Groups or Formations may make decisions about the wearing of face masks

Attendance is voluntary



Maintain good hygiene and cleaning

- Provide sanitiser at all entrances to the Scout Hall
- Arrange all touch surfaces and activity equipment to be regularly sanitised
- Display hand washing posters in the bathrooms and kitchens
- Remind participants to maintain hand hygiene
- Remind participants to practise respiratory hygiene



Stay Physically Distant

- Meetings in halls for groups up to 25 persons without density restrictions
- Meetings in halls for groups greater than 25 persons if compliant with 2 sqm per person. Permitted number of participants to be displayed
- Maintaining 1.5 metres physical distancing is recommended
- Arrange parent drop-off and pick-up outside of Scout Hall
- No handshaking
- Minimise sharing of activity equipment



Follow Advice

- Start of meetings briefing conducted to occur to ensure current arrangements are understood
- Stay home when sick
- You will be arranged to return home if you become unwell during an activity
