

SCOUTS ACT - COVIDSAFE SCOUTING

STEP 4.4 – 23 March 2021

Gatherings of up to 25 people (excluding staff) without space restrictions

Larger outdoor gatherings up to 500 people possible when compliant with 2 square metres per person

Accommodation recommendation is 2 sqm per person, whether indoors or in tents

Gatherings of 500 - 1000 people requires ACT Health to be notified and a COVID plan to be submitted

All attendees to be recorded. From 6 March meeting places to have the *Check in CBR* app QR code in place, and the app is required for use by those 16 years and older who enter and plan to be present for 15 minutes or longer.

What happens

Weekly, outdoor, and overnight activities

ACT & Interstate travel for activities permitted subject to government controls, regularly monitor prior to and during activity. Interstate travel for Scouting meetings, conferences, and similar is not currently permitted

Normal activity approval processes in place

Requirements

Vehicles may carry passengers from more than one household

Hand sanitiser freely available

GL and/or President ensures premises suitable for use, and premises including surfaces and equipment cleaned after each activity

No attendance if ill (Youth and Leaders), and exclude anyone not well and arrange for their return to home

Child safe practices maintained

Hall hirers briefed on operational arrangements
