

SCOUTS ACT – COVID SAFE SCOUTING OVERVIEW

STEP 6.3 – 12 November 2021

Gatherings of up to 1000 people permitted outdoors without density restrictions

Gatherings of up to 25 people permitted indoors without density restrictions

Gatherings of more than 25 persons permitted indoors if compliant with 2 square metres per person

All attendees to be recorded. Meeting places to have the *Check in CBR* app QR code in place, and the app is required for use by those 16 years and older who enter the premise

Face masks not required; Scout Groups or Formations may make decisions about the wearing of face masks

What happens

Weekly, outdoor, and overnight activities; Camp Cottermouth open; attendance is voluntary

Activities permitted in the ACT

Activities permitted anywhere in NSW and Victoria, however check for the latest conditions of those jurisdictions when planning, and before, any such activities commence

Requirements

Staying 1.5 metres apart remains recommended

Vehicles may carry passengers from more than one household

Hand sanitiser freely available

GL and/or President ensures premises suitable for use, hand sanitiser freely available, and premises including surfaces and equipment regularly cleaned. Hall hirers briefed on operational arrangements

No attendance if anyone is ill, and anyone not well to be excluded and their return to home arranged

Child safe practices maintained
