

## **11.1 - WEARING OF SCOUT DECORATIONS**

Uniformed and non-uniformed members of the Movement are often in doubt as to the occasions when it is correct to wear Scout decorations. The following may be a useful guide :

Generally speaking, Scout decorations may be worn at functions that are outside the normal Group or District activities, and it is correct to wear them on the following occasions:

Whenever a royal or vice-regal person is present;

Branch, Region or Group Annual Meetings;

Opening of Group headquarters or special Group functions such as gatherings to celebrate a Group's fifty years of Scouting;

Special functions at which distinguished guests are present.

Notices of gatherings should indicate if decorations are to be worn.

Leaders wear decorations with uniform; non-uniformed members or former Leaders wear them with civilian dress.
