

6.1.1 - CHIEF COMMISSIONER'S DIRECTIVE – Branch Uniformed Support Team

1. This Chief Commissioner's Directive is to be read in conjunction with Branch Policy 6.1 – Structure of Scouts ACT – Support for Scout Groups, Rover Crews and Fellowships.
2. The structure of the Branch Uniformed Support Team is set out in the following tables.
3. The Chief's Counsel consists of the Chief Commissioner, Assistant Chief Commissioners, Branch Rover Council Chair, Branch Venturer Council Chair and Principal Administrative Officer and usually meets on a fortnightly basis to provide counsel and advice to the Chief Commissioner.
4. In accordance with the Branch Constitution, clause 22.7, the Chief Commissioner meets with the Commissioners on a regular basis as follows:
 - a. Operations Team – consists of the Chief Commissioner, Assistant Chief Commissioners, their deputies and their Branch Advisers (which are development positions for young people), Camp Cottermouth Commissioner, Branch Rover Council Chair, Branch Venturer Council Chair and Principal Administrative Officer and nominally meets monthly.
 - b. All Commissioners Meeting – consists of all Commissioners and Members of the Operations Team and meets quarterly.
